The raw numbers are impressive: Martin Iron Works furnished more than 2,600 embed items for the concrete, fabricated and installed more than 240 tons of structural and miscellaneous steel, and installed 59 tons of steel joists and 50,500 square feet of metal decking.

But what took place behind the hardened steel is what set this premier fabrication and installation company apart as it teamed with Q&D Construction to build the West Coast's largest Toyota dealership.

Martin took a proactive approach to shop drawings and the detailing process, which allowed for the timely delivery of steel on the time-sensitive project.

The \$35 million project included a four-level, 245,000-square-foot structure encompassing a ground-floor service level and three levels of vehicle parking.

Detailing of the steel was expedited in order to begin delivery of more than 2,600 embeds to connect concrete and steel. Martin re-worked some of the original plans in order to avoid delays and conflicts with others aspects of the job.

many challenges in the design implementation and steel erection," said Q&D's Senior Project Manager Chris Sibley. "Thanks to their efforts, the steel erection for the entire project flowed smoothly."
